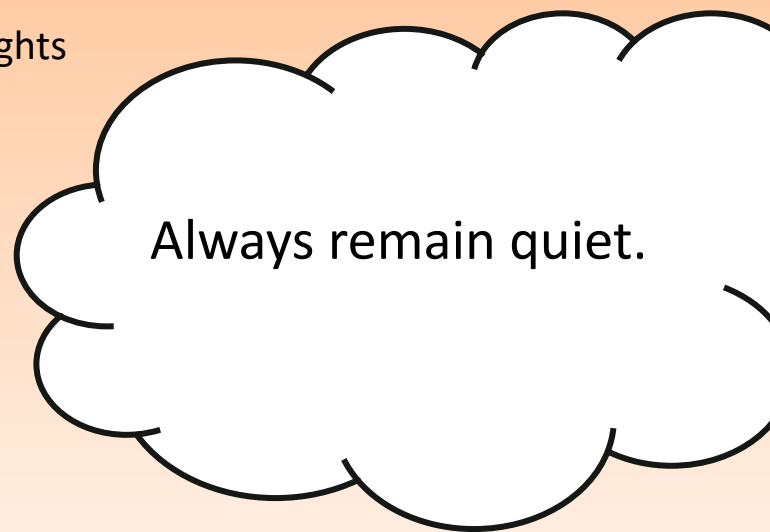


Mindfulness

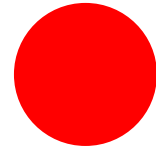
Tyler's experience at The Old Pheasantry :

Sushi

While Japan is no doubt the sushi capital of the world, we have Southeast Asia and China to thank for inspiring modern sushi. The practice of making sushi is estimated to have started as early as 500 B.C. in the rice-growing region of Southeast Asia, somewhere along the Mekong River.



There are many types of sushi, the most popular being *nigiri-zushi*, or hand-pressed sushi. This type of sushi originated from what was called *Edomae-zushi*. Edo is the old name of Tokyo. *Edomae* means 'in front of Edo' and referred to fish caught in front of the Edo castle and later, the fish and shellfish in Tokyo bay.



The ingredients to make Sushi are:

Dry seaweed

Japanese rice (and vinegar)

Any veg (carrot, cucumber)

Fish sticks (**the best ones**)

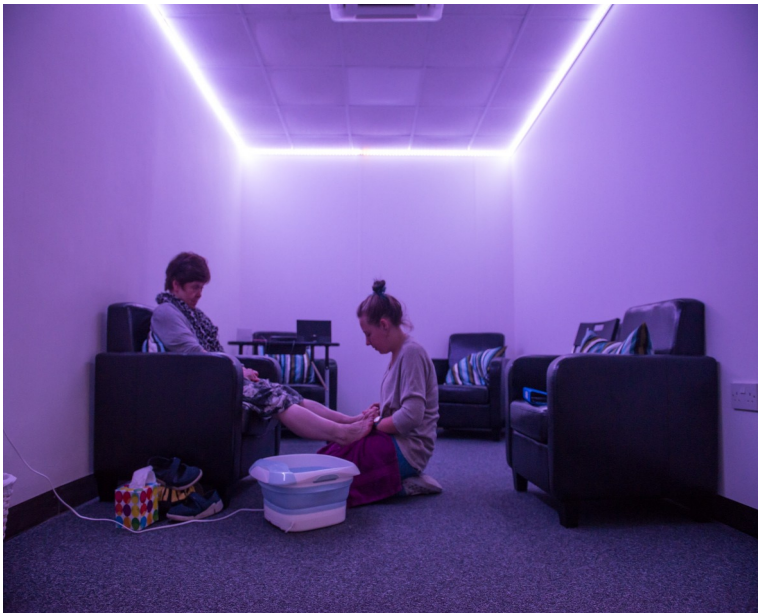
The sushi I made was used with seaweed, sushi rice, carrots, cucumber, and my favourite, the fish sticks.

You might as well also need a mat to roll the sushi, and after freezing it in the freezer, you use a knife to cut it into roll pieces.
