

Our Curriculum

At our pre-school, we offer a vibrant, play-focused curriculum that nurtures each child's individuality and natural curiosity. Rooted in holistic development, our approach blends joyful exploration with purposeful learning, ensuring every child feels seen, supported, and inspired.

We provide a rich variety of experiences—from cooking and STEM investigations to outdoor adventures and expressive arts. Weekly external drama and dance sessions add excitement and creativity, while our strong community connections help children develop a sense of belonging and empathy.

Our curriculum is designed to spark wonder and deliver the “wow factor” through engaging, hands-on activities that are tailored to each child's interests and developmental needs. We believe that learning should be exciting, meaningful, and full of discovery—laying the foundation for confident, lifelong learners.

Measurable Outcomes:

- Children demonstrate progress in the prime and specific areas of learning as outlined in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) framework, evidenced through regular observations and assessments.
- Each child's individual learning journey is documented, showing clear steps of development and achievement in personal, social, and emotional skills, communication and language, and physical development.
- Children participate confidently in group activities, including drama and dance, and show increased self-expression and collaboration.
- Engagement in STEM and cooking activities is tracked, with children displaying curiosity, problem-solving skills, and an ability to follow instructions and work safely.
- Outdoor learning and community-based experiences are reflected in children's growing understanding of the world, respect for others, and sense of responsibility.
- Regular review meetings with parents and carers demonstrate shared understanding of each child's progress and next steps.
Through this approach, we aim to lay secure foundations for lifelong learning, equipping children with the skills, knowledge, and attitudes necessary for future success.
